#### **Basic documents:**

- Passport
- 2 document size pictures
- Application form
- Application fees (normal rate is 2500CZK)
- Letter of acceptance\*
- Proof of accommodation\*
- Proof of financial means\*\*

#### Additional documents (depends on country):

- Criminal record extract\*\*
- Other\*\*

- \* should not be older than 180 days
- ' should be officially translated into Czech

## After Arrival Obligations

Accomodated at the university dormitory or not

- EU citizens
- Non-EU citizens with long-term visa
- Non-EU citizens with a long-stay visa issued for the purpose of collecting the longterm residence permit
- Non-EU citizens applying for the long-term residence permit

For visiting the Ministry of Interior/Department for Asylum and Migration Policy it is necessary to have an appointment reserved in advance. Therefore, we recommend making an appointment with the Ministry of Interior office <a href="https://frs.gov.cz/en">https://frs.gov.cz/en</a> right after you receive your visa in your country of origin and your date of arrival to the Czech Republic.
